

# SR 111 ROADWAY PROJECT

## Vista Chino - Gene Autry Trail - E. Palm Canyon



### FACT SHEET

Caltrans, in coordination with the City of Palm Springs and other local stakeholders, will complete roadway improvements on SR 111 beginning in mid-January 2025. The project spans from Golf Club Drive to West Gateway Drive and includes construction on SR 111, Vista Chino, Gene Autry Trail and E. Palm Canyon.

#### BENEFITS

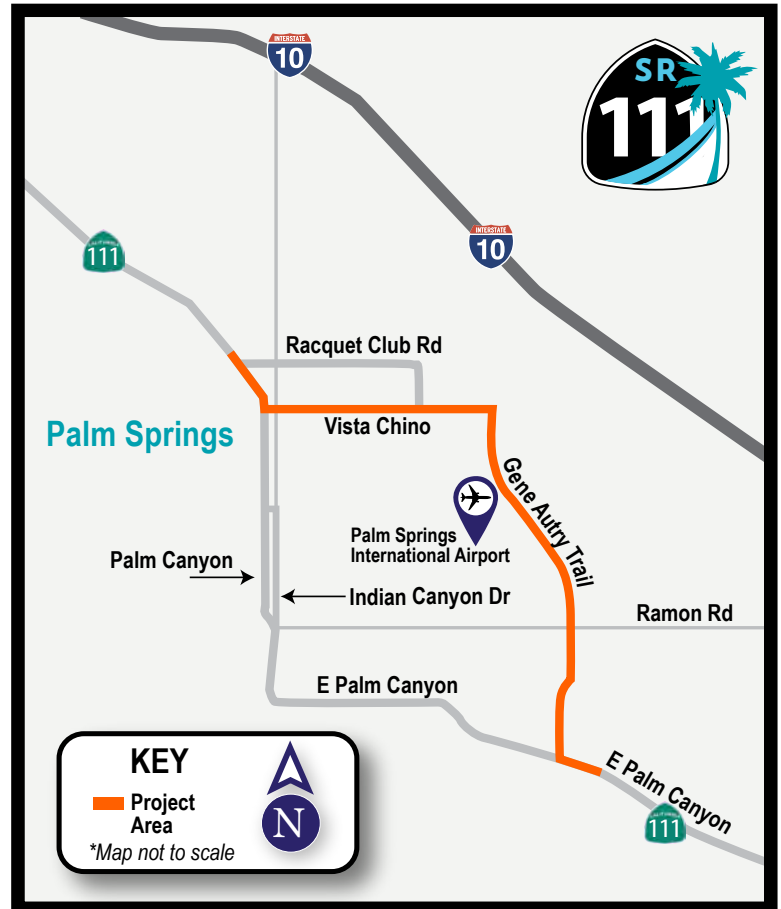
The SR 111 Roadway Project will improve road safety, pavement longevity, and accessibility.

Construction includes:

- Removing and repaving the existing asphalt concrete pavement on approximately 8 miles in the project area.
- Repairing pavement damaged by deterioration.
- Upgrading accessibility features including curb ramps and sidewalks at Golf Club Drive and North Palm Canyon Drive.
- Reconstructing 11 Sunline Transportation bus bays.
- Constructing new bus pads at existing bus stops.

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are planned in one direction at a time, for approximately one mile.
- Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained, with detour signage in place.
- Motorists can expect traffic congestion in the project area and are advised to choose alternate routes.
- Sunline bus stops in the project area will be impacted; riders may find information at [www.sunline.org](http://www.sunline.org)



#### Work hours

**Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

The contractor may work weekends and nighttime hours as needed, and advance notification will be provided. Posted schedules may change due to weather or field conditions.

The \$14 million project is funded through (SB) 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.
