SR 111 ROADWAY PROJECT

Vista Chino - Gene Autry Trail - E. Palm Canyon

FACT SHEET

Caltrans, in coordination with the City of Palm Springs and other local stakeholders, will complete roadway improvements on SR 111 beginning in mid-January 2025. The project spans from Golf Club Drive to West Gateway Drive and includes construction on SR 111, Vista Chino, Gene Autry Trail and E. Palm Canyon.

BENEFITS

The SR 111 Roadway Project will improve road safety, pavement longevity, and accessibility. Construction includes:

- Removing and repaying the existing asphalt concrete pavement on approximately 8 miles in the project area.
- Repairing pavement damaged by deterioration.
- Upgrading accessibility features including curb ramps and sidewalks at Golf Club Drive and North Palm Canyon Drive.
- Reconstructing 11 Sunline Transportation bus bays.
- Constructing new bus pads at existing bus stops.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are planned in one direction at a time, for approximately one mile.
- Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained, with detour signage in place.
- Motorists can expect traffic congestion in the project area and are advised to choose alternate routes.
- Sunline bus stops in the project area will be impacted; riders may find information at <u>www.sunline.org</u>

Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The contractor may work weekends and nighttime hours as needed, and advance notification will be provided. Posted schedules may change due to weather or field conditions.
